Homebound Service Application

The Eldredge Public Library offers Homebound Services to those patrons residing in Chatham who are unable to physically visit the library. "Homebound" is defined as being generally confined to a residence either temporarily or permanently, due to illness, injury, or physical disability. If a patron drives, they would not be eligible for homebound status. Patrons can either arrange for their own delivery of items, or request delivery service from the library.

Overdue fines will not be charged on homebound materials. However, the library's standard fee schedule will apply for damaged or lost items. All materials have a loan period of 4 weeks. Your library account must remain in good standing to continue to receive homebound services.
